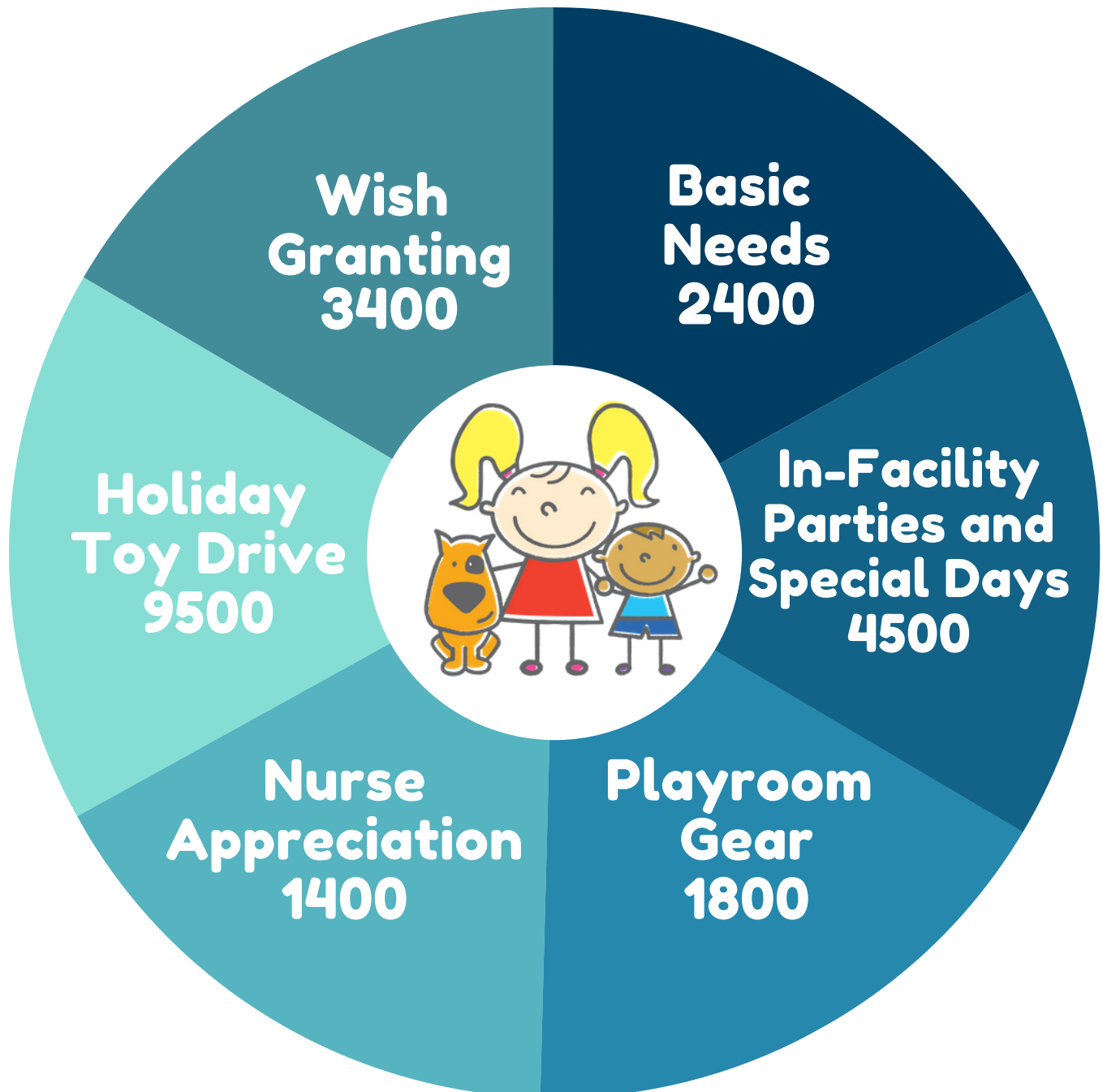
The nurses, social workers, and other professionals working with these children understand their unique situation and how to help them heal, but they often lack the resources and financial support to make them smile.

That is why they turn to Little Smiles, which provides the volunteers and supplies needed to bring joy to the lives of the children they care for.

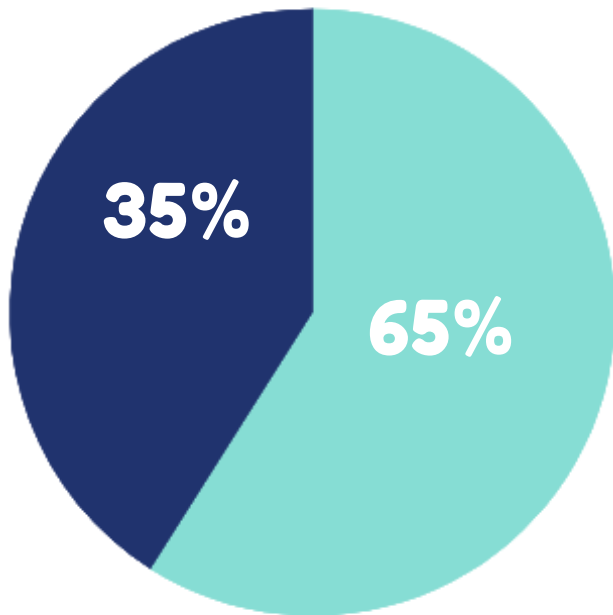

# Donations made to Little Smiles go a long way

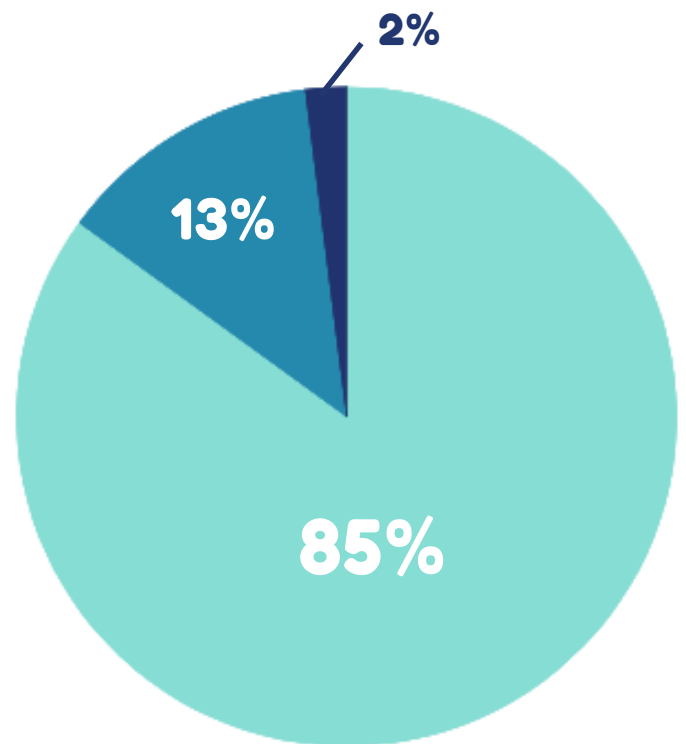
